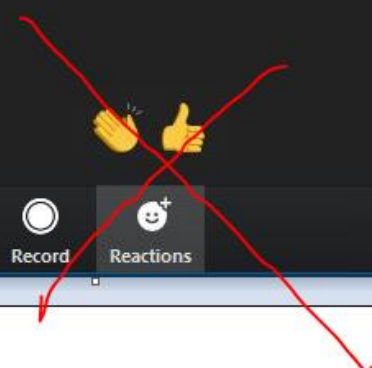

THEODORE C. WILLIAMS, ADAPTED


God is with me, gently o'er me
